Mae'r Cylch Meithrin yn cael ei redeg yng Nghaban y Plwyf (sydd ar dir yr ysgol) bob prynhawn rhwng 11:30yb a 2:55yp. Gall plant sydd yn mynchy dosbarth Meithrin (ysgol yn y bore yn unig) aros i gael cinio, ac yna i'r Cylch Meithrin Mwy yn y prynhawn. Gall plant o ddwy a hanner ddod i'r Cylch erbyn 11:30yb a chael cinio ysgol ac yna aros am weddill y prynhawn. Rydym hefyd yn rhan o gynllun 'Godi'n dair'. Golyga hyn y gall plentyn sydd yn cael ei ben-blwydd yn dair oed ym mis Hydref fynychu'r ysgol dechrau tymor y Gwanwyn, neu os oes plentyn yn cael ei ben-blwydd mis Chwefror, gall fynychu'r ysgol ar ôl y Pasg. Golyga hyn y gall plentyn fynychu'r ysgol yn gynt, yn hytrach na disgwyl tan y mis Medi canlynol.

The Cylch Meithrin is run in the Cabin (located on the school grounds) every afternoon between 11:30am and 2:55pm. Children attending our Nursery class (school in the morning only) can stay for lunch, and then go to the Meithrin Mwy in the afternoon. Children of two and a half can come to the Cylch by 11:30am and have a school lunch and stay for the rest of the afternoon. We are also part of the 'Raise three' scheme. This means that a child who has their third birthday in October can attend school at the start of the Spring term, or if a child has their birthday in February, they can attend school after Easter. This means that a child can attend school sooner, rather than waiting until the following September.

Ein Ysgol / Our School

Mae Ysgol Pant Pastynog yn gwasanaethu pentrefi Prion, Peniel, Saron, Nantglyn a'r ardal wledig o'i chwmpas yn ogystal a thref Dinbych.

Ysgol naturiol Gymraeg ydi hi a Chymraeg yw iaith gyntaf y mwyaf o'r disgylion. Cyflwynir Saesneg fel pwnc i'r plant ym mlwyddyn 3.

Mae'n ysgol dan reolaeth wirfoddol yr Eglwys yng Nghymru. Yn 1864, gadawodd Peter Jones ddarn o dir yn ei ew-yllys i'r diben o godi ysgol ym Mhrion i blant a phobl dlawd y plwyf. Ers hynny adeiladwyd ystafell ychwanegol yn 1890 a chantîn yn 1960.

Ceir tair ystafell dosbarth - un i blant Cyfnod Sylfaen, un i blant Bl 3 a 4 a'r llall i Fl5 a 6.

Defnyddir Neuadd yr ysgol ar gyfer gweithgareddau megis grwpiau targedu, gwersi offerynnau, cyd-addoli, addysg gorfforol ac fel ffreutur amser cinio.

Ysgol Pant Pastynog serves the villages of Prion, Peniel, Saron, Nantglyn and the rural area surrounding it as well as the town of Denbigh.

It's a natural Welsh School – and Welsh is the first language of the majority of the pupils. English is introduced to the children in year 3.

It is a Church of Wales voluntary controlled school. In 1864, Peter Jones left a plot of land in his will with the intent of building a school in Prion for the children and the poor of the parish. Since then, an extra room was built in 1890 and a canteen in 1960.

There are three classrooms – one for Foundation Phase children, one for Yrs 3 and 4 and another for Yrs 5 and 6.

The school Hall is used for activities such as targeting groups, instrument lessons, co-worship, physical education and is used as a canteen at lunch time.


OBJECTIVES

Our aim in school is to develop a sense of self-discipline in our pupils together with responsibility for their actions. This is done in a fitting atmosphere where respect for the individual and respect for the environment are important. Reward is the most effective way of managing behaviour, but we do follow our School Discipline Policy where there are consequences for our actions. We value the support of parents in this matter.

We also provide fruit for the children to eat at playtime and kindly ask for a contribution of £1 per week for Foundation Phase Children and £1.25 for children in Yr 3 to 6. This can be paid via Parentpay.



Gwisg Ysgol School Uniform

Disgwylawn i bob disgybl wisgo gwisg ysgol. Polisi'r ysgol yw gwneud y wisg ysgol mor rhesymol ac ymarferol â phosibl. Gellir archebu'r wisg drwy'r ysgol, bydd archebion yn cael eu gwneud unwaith y flwyddyn ym mis Mai/Mehefin ond gallwch brynu eitemau yn Workplace Worksafe, Rhuthun unrhyw adeg o'r flwyddyn.

We expect every pupil to wear school uniform. The school policy is to make the uniform as reasonable and practical as possible. Uniform can be ordered through the school, an order is done once a year in May/June time but items can be purchased in Workplace Worksafe, Ruthin at any time of the year.

TGCh / ITC

Gan fod gennyn ni adnoddau TGCh ardderchog, rydym yn annog ein plant i ddatblygu eu sgiliau TGCh ar draws y cwricwlwm. Drwy defnyddio iPads, gliniaduron, chromebooks ac amrywiaeth o apiau rydym yn cyfoethogi addysg a phrofiadau'r plant.

As we have excellent IT resources, we encourage our children to develop their IT skills across the curriculum. Through the use of iPads, laptops, chromebooks and a variety of apps we enrich the children's education and experiences.



Cart Y Plwyf / Minibus

Rydym yn ffodus iawn bod gan yr ysgol Fws Mini. Dyma adnodd gwerthfawr iawn nid yn unig i'r Ysgol ond hefyd i'r Gymuned. Defnyddiwn y bws yn rheolaidd i fynd a'r plant am wersi nofio, cystadleuthau chwaraeon ac ymweliadau addysgiadol ar hyd y flwyddyn.

We are very fortunate that the school has a Mini Bus. This is a very valuable resource not only for the School but also for the Community. We regularly use the bus to take the children for swimming lessons, sports competitions and educational visits during the year.

- ddysgwr uchelgeisiol, galluog, sy'n barod i ddysgu drwy gydol eu hoes,
- yn gyfrannwr mentrus, creadigol, sy'n barod i chwarae rhan lawn mewn bywyd a gwaith
- dinesydd egwyddorol, gwybodus, sy'n barod i chwarae rhan yng Nghymru a'r byd, ac
- unigolyn iach, hyderus, sy'n barod i fyw bywyd cyflawn fel aelod gwerthfawr o gymdeithas.

Yma yn Ysgol Pant Pastynog, bydd eich plentyn yn dysgu drwy'r chwe Maes Dysgu a Phrofiad sef - Celfyddydau mynegiannol, lechyd a lles, Dyniaethau, leithoedd, llythrennedd a chyfathrebu, Mathemateg a rhifedd a Gwyddoniaeth a thechnoleg (gan gynnwys cyfrifiadureg).

Yng nghlwm i'r chwe Maes Dysgu byddent yn dysgu sgiliau llythrennedd, rhifedd a digidol ar draws y cwricwlwm.

Mae'r cwricwlwm hefyd yn ymdrin â:


- hawlau dynol
- amrywiaeth a pharchu gwahaniaethau
- profiadau a sgiliau ar gyfer gyrfaoedd a'r gweithle
- dysgu am gyd-destunau lleol, cenedlaethol a rhynghladol
- addysg cydberthnasoedd a rhywioldeb sy'n briodol o ran datblygiad y plentyn.

Mae pob maes dysgu a phrofiad yn cynnwys atganiadau o'r hyn sy'n bwysig sy'n llywio dysgu plant o bob oed. Mae'r rhain yn helpu eich plentyn i feddwl am yr hyn y mae'n ei ddysgu a sut mae pynciau'n cysylltu gyda'i gilydd, gyda gwaith a gyda bywyd. Maen nhw hefyd yn helpu plant i wneud cynnydd bob blwyddyn wrth iddyn nhw feithrin eu sgiliau a dealltwriaeth.

Mae'r athrawon yn cynllunio yn ôl y datganiadau o'r hyn sydd yn bwysig ymhob Maes Dysgu a Phrofiad. Yn y Cyfnod Sylfaen, rhawn gyfle i'r plant ddysgu drwy chwarae yn y gwahanol ardaloedd dysgu: ardal iaith, ymchwiliol, rhif, adeiladu, TGCH, ardal tu allan ac ardal creadigol. Addysgir yn gyfan gwbl drwy gyfrwng yr iaith Gymraeg. Yng Nghyfnod Allweddol 2, er mai Cymraeg yw'r brif iaith addysgu, cyflwynir Saesneg a defnyddir hwn wrth gasglu a chyflwyno gwybodaeth oddi fewn yr holl Meysydd Dysgu.

Gwnawn ein gorau i baratoi rhaglen o waith sy'n addas ar gyfer pob gallu a chyrhaeddiad gan anelu i sicrhau cysondeb, cynnydd a dilyniant ymhob agwedd o'r cwricwlwm. Gwneir hyn o fewn awyrgylch hapus a chadarnhaol sy'n hybu'r dysgu. Caiff y plant eu hannog i ddatblygu hunanhwyder ac annibyniaeth wrth ddysgu sgiliau mewn amrywiaeth o sefyllfaoedd.

Curriculum

From September 2022, Ysgol Pant Pastynog has adopted the New Curriculum for Wales. The new curriculum is designed to realise the Four purposes of developing your child/children to become:-

- an ambitious, capable learner, who is ready to learn throughout their life,
- an enterprising, creative contributor, who is ready to play a full part in life and work
- a principled, informed citizen, who is ready to play a role in Wales and the world, and
- a healthy, confident individual, who is ready to live a full life as a valuable member of society.

Here at Ysgol Pant Pastynog, your child will learn through the six Areas of Learning and Experience namely - Expressive Arts, Health and well-being, Humanities, Languages, literacy and communication, Mathematics and numeracy and Science and technology (including computer science).

Linked to the six Learning Areas they would learn literacy, numeracy and digital skills across the curriculum. The curriculum also covers:

- human rights
- diversity and respect for differences
- experiences and skills for careers and the workplace
- learn about local, national and international contexts
- Relationships and Sexuality Education, which is appropriate in terms of the child's development.

Each area of learning and experience includes statements of what is important that guides the learning of children of all ages. These help your child to think about what they are learning and how subjects connect with each other, with work and with life. They also help children make progress each year as they build their skills and understanding.

The teachers plan according to the What matter's statements in each Area of Learning and Experience. In the Foundation Phase, we give the children the opportunity to learn through play in the different learning areas: language area, investigative, number, construction, ICT, outside area and creative area. It is taught entirely through the medium of the Welsh language. In Key Stage 2, although Welsh is the main teaching language, English is introduced and this is used when collecting and presenting information within all the Areas of Learning.

We do our best to prepare a scheme of work that is suitable for all abilities and attainments aiming to ensure consistency, progress and progression in every aspect of the curriculum. This is done within a happy and positive atmosphere which promotes learning. The children are encouraged to develop self-confidence and independence while learning skills in a variety of situations.

Homework is set occasionally, to complement the work going on in class. We kindly ask that the children read regularly at home please.

Salwch Illness

Os yw eich plentyn yn sâl mae'n bwysig eich bod yn ffonio'r ysgol cyn 8.45 y bore. Mae'n bosib i'r staff roi ffisig i'ch plentyn os ydynt wedi cael prescriptiwn gan y doctor, ond bydd angen i'r rhiant lenwi ffurflen caniatâd.

The school has a sickness policy. It is important that any child that has been vomiting be kept at home for 48 hours after the last time they were sick or had a bout of diarrhoea. If a child is ill the parent must phone the school before 8.45am that day. It is possible for staff to give medication to children but the parent must complete a permission form beforehand.

Prospective Parents

Prospective parents are invited to visit the school to meet the head teacher and to sample the working atmosphere of the school at any time during the year. Contact the school to arrange a date and time.

Charging Policy

The Charging Policy is based on the guidelines of Denbighshire Education Authority. Every parental contribution is voluntary.

- The Governing Body have decided to charge for instrumental lessons.
- We ask for a contribution towards an educational visit and transport costs for swimming lessons and parents are given notice of this in advance.
- The Governing Body can charge for any damage to school property arising from misbehaviour by a pupil.
- In accordance with the policy of the LEA, the Governors will aim to refund if the parents are in receipt of Family Income Support or Family Tax Credit.





lechyd a Lles

Fel rhan o'u gwersi Addysg Gorfforol, bydd y plant ieuengaf yn ymarfer tri maes: gemau, gweithgareddau gymnasteg a dawns. Bydd plant o Flwyddyn 1 i Flwyddyn 6 yn derbyn gwersi nofio am gyfnod o 6 wythnos. Yn CA2 yn ychwanegol at hyn, bydd y plant yn cymryd rhan mewn gweithgareddau athletaidd, awyr agored, tenis, rownderi a gwahanol gystadlaethau drwy'r Urdd a Dyffryn Clwyd. Rydym hefyd yn annog fod y plant i ddeall pwysigrwydd yfed digon o ddŵr, bwyta'n iach ac edrych ar ôl eu hiechyd corfforol a meddyliol.

Yn y gwersi Addysg Gorfforol, disgwylir i'r plant wisgo crys T gwyn, siorts du ac esgidiau addas. Rydym yn annog y plant i ymgymryd hyd eithaf eu gallu â'r holl weithgareddau addysg gorfforol. Cyn i bob plentynadael yr ysgol ym Mlwyddyn 6, rydym yn sicrhau ei bod wedi cael gwersi beicio ac yn gallu nofio 25m heb gymorth.

Rydym yn cael 'Wythnos lechyd, Lles a Ffitrwydd' a diwrnodau lles sy'n llawn gweithgareddau megis gweithgareddau coginio, awyr agored, a gweithgareddau tîm.

Yn ystod y flwyddyn caiff y plant gyfle i gymryd rhan mewn amrywiol weithgareddau: Mabolgampau'r Ysgol, Pêl droed yr Urdd, Rygbi'r Urdd, Pêl Rwyd yr Urdd ac Athletau'r Urdd yn ogystal â gwyliau Dyffryn Clwyd fel Hoci, Rownderi, Trawsgwlad a Chriced.

Health and Wellbeing

As part of their Physical Education lessons, the youngest children will practice three areas: games, gymnastic activities and dance. Children from Year 1 to Year 6 will receive swimming lessons for a period of 6 weeks. In KS2 in addition to this, the children will take part in athletic activities, outdoors, tennis, rounders and various competitions through the Urdd and Vale of Clwyd. We also encourage the children to understand the importance of drinking enough water, eating healthily and looking after their physical and mental health.

In the Physical Education lessons, the children are expected to wear a white T-shirt, black shorts and suitable shoes. We encourage the children to undertake to the best of their ability all physical education activities. Before each child leaves school in Year 6, we ensure that she has had cycling lessons and can swim 25m unaided.

We have 'Health, Wellbeing and Fitness Week' and wellness days which are full of activities such as cooking, outdoor activities and team activities.

During the year the children have the opportunity to take part in various activities: School Sports, Urdd Football, Urdd Rugby, Urdd Netball and Urdd Athletics and Vale of Clwyd Festivals such as Hockey, Rounders, Cross Country and Cricket.



Presenoldeb Attendance

Mae presenoldeb yn dda iawn yn Ysgol Pant Pastynog.

Pan fo plentyn yn absennol, disgwyllir i rieni gysylltu â'r ysgol mor fuan ag sy'n bosibl i egluro'r absenoldeb – un ai drwy ffonio'r ysgol neu drwy yrru e-bost. Os nad oes eglurhad, yna bydd yr ysgol yn cysylltu gyda'r rhiant oherwydd gweithdrefnau diogelu. Presenoldeb yr ysgol gyfan ar 01/07/24 oedd 94.5%.

Attendance is very good in Ysgol Pant Pastynog.

When a child is absent, we expect the parents to contact school as soon as possible – either by phone or by sending an email. If there is no explanation, then the school will contact the parent, in line with safeguarding procedures. Whole school attendance as at 01/07/24 was 94.5%.

Mae ganddom Bwyllgor Eglwys o dan ogwydd Lles yr ysgol, sydd yn cynnal gwasanaethau ac yn trefnu gweithgareddau ar gyfer y gymuned. Eleni bu iddynt benderfynu codi arian a chasglu bwyd tuag at Fanc Bwyd Dinbych.

The school has a close link with the Cathedral in St Asaph. Mr Neil Roberts, our Bishop Visitor will visit us every term to hold a service and discuss with the staff and children.

We have a Church Committee under the school's Wellbeing focus, which holds services and organizes activities for the community. This year they decided to raise money and collect food for Denbigh Food Bank.



Gweithgareddau Darllen

Mae'n le gwych i gael gwersi Gwyddoniaeth ac fe gawn ambell i stori yn y pergola. Mae'r Ardal Gloddi yn denu'r plant i chwarae'n greadigol iawn. Yn y Gwanwyn, mae gynon ni lefydd addas i blannu blodau ym mlaen yr ysgol er mwyn gwneud y lle'n fwy deniadol. Yn ein gardd gan fod angen dyfrhau'r planhigion, mae gennym dwbiau dŵr i ddal y dŵr glaw sy'n disgyn o do'r garej.

Mae gan plant y Cyfnod Sylfaen ddosbarth tu allan, sy'n addas i'w ddefnyddio ymhob tywydd, ble byddent yn gallu dysgu a chwarae tybiau tywod a dŵr.

Our garden is an environmentally friendly area – where children can relax at playtime and a place where lessons can be held. It's an excellent setting for our Science lessons and the pergola can be used for storytelling. The Digging Area offers the children an opportunity to play creatively. In the Spring, there are suitable places to plant flowers in front of the school in order to make the place more attractive. In our garden as the plants need to be watered, we have water tubs to catch the rainwater that falls from the garage roof.

Children in the Foundation Phase have an outside classroom, which is suitable for use in all weathers, where they are able to learn and play in sand and water tubs.



Addysg Cydberthynas a Rhywioldeb

Relationships and Sexuality Education

Mae pwnc Addysg Rhyw yn cael ei addysgu gyda sensitifrwydd. Nid yw'n bwnc ar wahân ond wedi'i integreiddio i'r ddarpariaeth addysg bersonol, gymdeithasol ac iechyd. Mae'n galw am fod yn agored yn yr ystafell ddosbarth ac atebion gonest i gwestiynau wrth iddynt godi o wersi unigol yn hytrach na gwersi unigol sy'n cael eu neilltuo i'r pwnc gyda'r dosbarth cyfan. Dylai pwysigrwydd bywyd teuluol a pherthnasau cariadus a gofalgar yn y cyddestun hwnnw fod yn nodwedd ganolog o'r agwedd hon ar y Cwricwlwm. Os oes unrhyw riant yn pryderu am yr agwedd hon ar y cwricwlwm, yna mae croeso i chi ei drafod gyda'r Pennaeth.

The subject of Sex Education is taught with sensitivity. It is not a discrete subject but integrated into the personal, social and health education provision. It calls for openness in the classroom and honest replies to questions as they arise from individual rather than isolated lessons devoted to the subject with the whole class. The importance of a family life and loving and caring relationships within that context should be a central feature of this aspect of the Curriculum. If any parent is concerned about this aspect of the curriculum then please feel free to discuss it with the Headteacher.



Ysgol Uwchradd Secondary School

Ar ddiwedd eu cyfnod yn yr ysgol, mae'r disgyblion yn mynd i Ysgol Uwchradd Glan Clwyd. Mae cyswllt gref rhwng Ysgol Glan Clwyd â ni. Trefnir gweithgareddau trosglwyddo a bydd aelod o staff o'r ysgol uwchradd yn ymweld â'r disgyblion ar ddiwedd tymor yr Haf.

Ceir nosweithiau agored ar ddechrau tymor yr Hydref yn Ysgolion Uwchradd yr ardal i roi cyfle i'r disgyblion a'u rhieni ymweld â'r ysgolion. Hefyd, caiff y disgyblion dreulio diwrnod yn yr ysgol uwchradd yn nhymor yr Haf er mwyn cael blas ar fywyd Ysgol Uwchradd.

At the end of their time in the school, the pupils go to Ysgol Glan Clwyd. There is a strong link between Glan Clwyd and us. Transitional activities are arranged and a member of staff from the high school comes to meet our pupils at the end of the Summer term.

There is an Open Evening in local High Schools at the start of the Autumn term to give pupils and their parents an opportunity to visit the school. Pupils can also spend a day in the High School during the Summer term to have a taste of life in a secondary school.



Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol Additional Learning Needs

Nod yr ysgol ydi datblygu pob disgybl hyd at eithaf ei allu ac mae'r ddarpariaeth ar gael yn cynorthwyo'r disgyblion i wneud hynny. Yr ysgol sy'n gyfrifol am leoli'r plant ar y camau a nodir yng Nghod Ymarfer Anghenion Dysgu ychwanegol Cymru ac am fonitro, adolygu ac am ddyrannu adnoddau.

Y Pennaeth â'r Cydlynnydd Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol CADY (sef Manon Tudur) sy'n gyfrifol am gydlynny'r ddarpariaeth briodol, gan gynnig cefnogaeth ac arweiniad i athrawon a rhieni o fewn yr ysgol. Mae aelod o'r Corff Llywodraethol hefyd wedi'i dewis i fonitro'r ddarpariaeth.

The aim of the school is to develop every pupil to the best of his/her ability and provision is in place to enable pupils to do this. It is the school's responsibility to place children in the stages described in the Welsh Additional Learning Needs Code of Practice', and to monitor, review and allocate resources.

The Headteacher with the Additional Learning Needs Co-ordinator of ALN (Manon Tudur) is in charge of the appropriate interventions as well as providing support and guidance to teachers and parents within the school. A member of the Governing Body has also been chosen to monitor the provision.



Cyfle Cyfartal Equal Opportunities

Yn Ysgol Pant Pastynog, caiff pob plentyn ei werthfawrogi waeth beth fo'i hil na'i ryw – rhawn yr un chwarae teg i bawb. Ategir hyn yn y Polisi Cyfle Cyfartal a gadarnhawyd gan y Corff Llywodraethol.

Mae'r plant yn gweithio mewn grwpiau cymysg a chaiff pob plentyn y cyfle i gymryd rhan yng ngweithgareddau'r ysgol. Ceisiwn sicrhau nad yw themâu a gyflwynir yn yr ysgol yn portreadu rôl-stereo nac yn ffafrio un plentyn ar draul y llall.

In Ysgol Pant Pastynog, every child is valued – whatever his/her race or sex - we treat every child fairly. This is reinforced in the Equal Opportunity Policy which has been accepted by the Governing Body.

Children work in mixed groups and every child has the opportunity to take part in school activities. We strive to ensure that no themes used in school portray stereotypical roles or favour one child over the other.

Darpariaeth ar gyfer plant ag anableddau Provision with pupils with disabilities

Addaswyd yr ysgol fel bod mynediad addas parhaol ar gyfer pob ymwelydd â'r ysgol. Rydym am sicrhau na fydd plentyn anabl, waeth beth fo'i anabledd, yn cael ei drin yn llai ffafriol na phlant eraill.

The school has been altered so that there is permanent suitable access to the school for everyone. We aim to make sure that no disabled child, whatever his/her disability, will be dealt with less respect than any other child.

Mae canllawiau Cwricwlwm i Gymru yn nodi ein bod yn asesu am dri rheswm allweddol sef:


- cefnogi dysgwyr unigol yn barhaus, o ddydd i ddydd,

Mae asesu yn rhan allweddol i gefnogi pob dysgwr unigol i wneud cynnydd ar hyd yr un continwwm ar gyflymder priodol, gan sicrhau eu bod yn cael eu cefnogi a'u herio i gyrraedd eu potensial. Mae asesu yn ymwneud ag asesu cynnydd dysgwyr yn barhaus - peidio â llunio barn un tro ar adegau penodol mewn pryd. Mae angen asesu i adlewyrchu y gall dilyniant dysgwyr fod yn amrywiol gyda chryfderau gwahanol ac mae angen iddo wella felly nid yw'n gwneud synnwyr categoreiddio dysgwyr i lefel 'ffit orau' benodol. Rydym yn defnyddio'r Disgrifiadau Dysgu ar gyfer bob Datganiad o'r hyn sy'n bwysig ar gyfer asesu a chynllunio ar gyfer cynnydd dysgwyr. Mae'r rhain yn fras i ddisgwyliadau ar gyfer oedrannau 5, 8, 11, 14 ac 16 oed, ac yn cynnig arweiniad ar sut y dylai dysgwyr ddangos cynnydd o fewn pob datganiad.

Yn Ysgol Pant Pastynog rydym yn defnyddio amrywiol strategaethau asesu fel diben cyffredinol i gefnogi pob dysgwr i wneud cynnydd. Yn ogystal â hyn, mae asesu yn llywio'r camau nesaf o ran dysgu ac addysgu. Mae ein hasesiadau'n cefnogi cynnydd dysgwyr unigol yn barhaus o ddydd i ddydd; yn nodi, cofnodi a myfyrio ar gynnydd dysgwyr unigol dros amser; ac yn deall cynnydd grwpiau er mwyn adlewyrchu ar ein hymarfer. Cynnydd ac Asesu

The Curriculum for Wales guidelines state that we assess for three key reasons which are:

- support individual learners continuously, day to day,
- note, capture and reflect on the progress of individual learners over time,
- understand group progress in order to reflect on practice.

Assessment is a key part of supporting each individual learner to progress along the same continuum at an appropriate pace, ensuring that they are supported and challenged to reach their potential. Assessment is about assessing learners' progress on an ongoing basis - not making a one-off judgment at specific points in time. Assessment needs to reflect that learner progression can be varied with different strengths and needs to improve so it does not make sense to categorize learners into a specific 'best fit' level. We use the Learning Descriptions for each Statement of what matters for assessment and planning for learner progress. These roughly correspond to expectations for ages 5, 8, 11, 14 and 16, and offer guidance on how learners should demonstrate progress within each statement.


At Ysgol Pant Pastynog we use various assessment strategies as a general purpose to support all learners to make progress. In addition to this, assessment informs the next steps in terms of learning and teaching. Our assessments continuously support the progress of individual learners on a day-to-day basis; notes, records and reflects on the progress of individual learners over time; and understand the progress of groups in order to reflect on our practice. We also assess and monitor the wellbeing of all learners (PASS). These assessments are used to draw up a detailed snapshot that provides attainment, progress and well-being targets.

Principles of Progression

- Increasing breadth and depth of knowledge
- Deepening understanding of the ideas and disciplines within the Areas
- Refinement and growing sophistication in the use and application of skills
- Making connections and transferring learning into new contexts
- Increasing effectiveness

Progression supported by descriptions of learning which provide guidance on how learners should progress within each statement of what matters

- Arranged in 5 progression steps to guide pace
- Framed from learner's perspective
- Framed broadly to sustain learning over a series of years
- Broadly set against ages of 5, 8, 11, 14 and 16
- Stand-alone tasks or activities
- Assessment criteria
